Those working with two to three year olds including Early Years Practitioners, Leaders, Managers, Children's Centre teachers, and other professionals.

## Dr. Jonathan Doherty



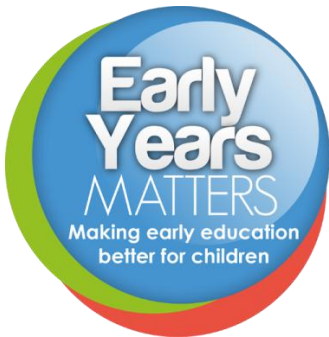
